Article II, Section B.1 (p. 14)

Teacher Duty Days: The teacher duty year will be made up of 196 paid duty days, which include the six (6) paid holidays within the regular school year. The District may, however, reduce the number of duty days to no fewer than 185 during the teacher duty year. In the event of a reduction of duty days, the salary schedule shall be reduced by .5% for each day reduced.

Following a reduction of duty days below 196 per teacher duty year, the District may increase the number of duty days to no more than 196. In the event of such an increase, the salary schedule shall be increased by .5% for each duty day added.

Opening Week: As part of the ~~196-day~~ work year . . . [remainder continues unchanged].

- As soon as possible, enter into a Memorandum of Agreement for 2017-18 implementing a 2-day work load reduction and 1% pay reduction. The two days eliminated would be the last two student days -- June 11 and 12, 2018.
